## WHY SHOULD YOU VOTE?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2020, only 66.8% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2024 election cycle.

## DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN CALIFORNIA



### VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

**October 21**

Fifteen days before an election. Same-day registration is permitted through Election Day.



### ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

**Application Not Required**

Application Not Required [All Mail]



### BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Must be received no later than 7 days after Election Day. Postmarked by Election Day

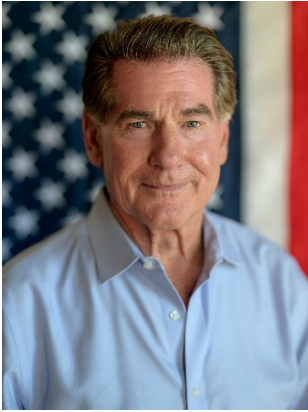

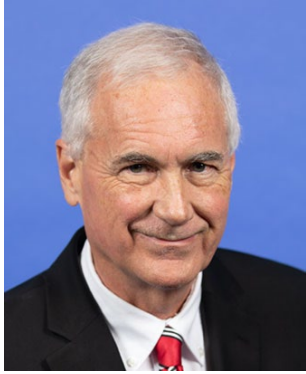

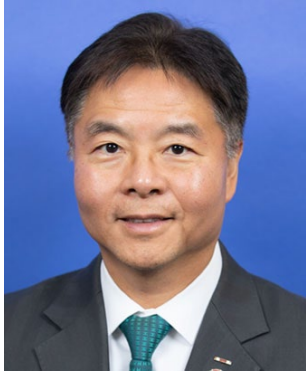
