WHY SHOULD YOU VOTE?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2020, only 66.8% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2024 election cycle.



CONNECTICUT'S ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

- Excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted via mail, in-person, email, fax



CONNECTICUT'S EARLY VOTING DEADLINES

Early Voting **Begins:** **October 21**

Early Voting **Ends:** **November 3**

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN CONNECTICUT



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 18

Eighteen days before an election. Same-day registration is permitted on Election Day.



ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

November 4

The day before the election.



BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Must be received by the close of polls on Election Day. Hand-delivered ballots must be received the day before an election if in person and by the close of polls on Election Day if delivered to a dropbox
Mail Receipt by Election Day

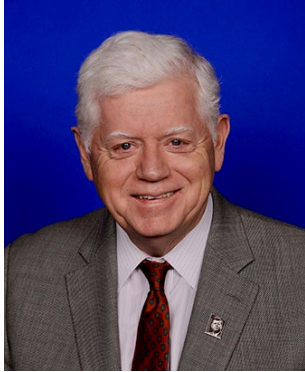
