# DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN WASHINGTON, DC

#### **VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:**

### October 15

Twenty-one days before an election. Same-day registration is permitted through early voting and on Election Day.

### ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by


### October 21

Fifteen days before the election.

# \* \* \* \* \* BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Must be received within 7 days of the election if postmarked on or before Election Day.
