WHY SHOULD YOU VOTE?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2020, only 66.8% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2024 election cycle.



NEVADA'S ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

- Ballots are delivered to all voters



NEVADA'S EARLY VOTING DEADLINES

Early Voting **Begins:** **October 19**

Early Voting **Ends:** **November 1**



DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN NEVADA



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 8

Twenty-eight days before an election in-person; 5 days before if registering online. Same-day registration is permitted during early voting and on Election Day.



ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

Application Not Required

Application Not Required [All Mail]



BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Must be received within four days of the election if postmarked by Election Day. Postmarked by Election Day

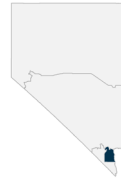

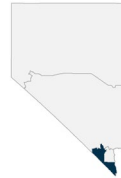
