WHY SHOULD YOU VOTE?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2020, only 66.8% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2024 election cycle.



MICHIGAN'S ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

- No excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted via mail, in-person, online



MICHIGAN'S EARLY VOTING DEADLINES

Early Voting **Begins: September 26***

Early Voting **Ends: November 4****

*In person absentee; October 26, 2024 early voting
**In person absentee; November 3 early voting

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN MICHIGAN



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 21; November 5 in-person

Fifteen days before an election. Same-day registration is permitted on Election Day.



ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

**November 1 by mail;
November 4 in-person;
November 5 emergency request**

The Friday before the election for mailed-out ballots; 4 PM on the day before Election Day for in-person requests.



BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Must be received by 8 PM Election Day. Mail Receipt by Election Day

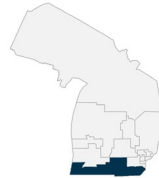

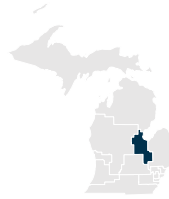
