GENERAL ELECTION DAY

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN ILLINOIS

* * * * * * * * * * * * * * VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 8 in-person; October 20 online

Twenty-eight days before an election; sixteen days before if registering online. Same-day registration is permitted before the election and on Election Day.

* * * * *

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

October 31 by mail or online; November 4 inperson

Five days before the election for online mailed-out ballots; the day before the election for in-person requests.

* * * * * BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Must be received within 14 days of the election if postmarked on or before Election Day.
Postmarked by Election Day
